$$\frac{3 \pm 4\sqrt{6}}{3} \quad \begin{cases} \frac{3+4\sqrt{6}}{3} = 4.27 \\ \frac{3-4\sqrt{6}}{3} = -2.27 \end{cases}$$

Then  $\div$  Bottom, =  
 $3+4\sqrt{6} = 12.797958\dots$
